This fall, the MBTA is heading to the ocean again for our fall convention, beginning with a cruise, reception, Downeast lobster bake and auction on Friday, September 14, at the Samoset Resort in Rockport. On Saturday, September 15, the MBTA will host our 5th Annual Fall Golf Tournament at the Samoset Resort Golf Club. (Registration and check-in begins at 7:30 a.m. and the scramble start is at 8:30 a.m.)

The MBTA Fall Convention is a great networking opportunity, and we hope you will plan on attending this fun event. The Samoset has been a favorite gathering place for MBTA members, from the very first days of our organization 78 years ago, and it will be great to be back there again this fall.

The Convention will kick off on Friday afternoon with a cruise of beautiful Rockland Harbor. Saturday morning will feature a golf tournament at the beautiful Samoset Resort Golf Club. An awards luncheon after the tournament will conclude the MBTA Convention events; however, those who wish to enjoy the Camden-Rockport area on their own may enjoy the discounted room rate which the Samoset has extended to Saturday night as well. There are a limited number of rooms available, so please make your room reservations soon.
